## Commissioner Year-End Report 10-06-2021

### Season-End Update

- **Rosters and Dues Payment** – There are currently 177 Members on all teams for the 2021 season.
  - **Tuesday** – 44 Members - \$880 dues collected
  - **Wednesday** – 45 Members - \$900 dues collected
  - **Thursday** – 43 Members - \$860 dues collected
  - **Friday** – 45 Members - \$900 dues collected (1 not collected)

There were two (2) teams who dropped out of the league for the 2021 season. Wednesday Team 6 (Mike Alexander Captain) and Wednesday Team 7 (Kathy Kulka Captain). The waiting list was used to fill the new teams and rosters. New teams joining this season were Wednesday Team 6 (Dave Perry Captain) and Wednesday Team 7 (Brenda Rippole Captain). There remains a wait list for those who have expressed an interest in joining the league when openings become available. The teams who dropped out for this season were added to the wait list and there are currently 36 people on the wait list.
